COVID-19 Testing Kits

Vault- www.learn.vaulthealth.com/nm

- 1. Order your test from Vault. The test kit will arrive at your home via expedited shipping.
- 2. Log on for a virtual visit with a Vault test supervisor; they will show you how to collect your saliva sample.
- 3. Ship your sample to the lab in Oakdale using a prepaid UPS package.
- 4. Get your result 24 to 48 hours after your sample arrives at the lab

Types of Tests

PCR (Polymerase chain reaction)- PCR (polymerase chain reaction) tests are a fast, highly accurate way to diagnose certain infectious diseases and genetic changes. The tests work by finding the DNA or RNA of a pathogen (disease-causing organism) or abnormal cells in a sample.

Self-Test or At-Home Test (Antigen tests)- At-home COVID-19 antigen tests detects proteins, called antigens, from the SARS-CoV-2 (the virus that causes COVID-19). At-home COVID-19 antigen tests are less likely to detect the SARS-CoV-2 virus than molecular tests, such as polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests.
